Purging of Inactive Records

Cumberland Mountain Community Services Board, located in Cedar Bluff, Tazewell, Grundy, and Lebanon, Virginia will destroy inactive individual records beginning September 1, 2013 according to the Code of Virginia Section 42.1-79.1. The individual or an authorized representative will have an opportunity to request possession of their record by calling our office. Proof of identity will be required. Included in the purging will be any adult record inactive prior to December 31, 2006, as well as inactive records of juveniles who are at least 18 years of age or have been inactive 6 years, whichever is longest. This purging will include inactive records (as described above) from all programs administered by Cumberland Mountain Community Services Board. The deadline to contact Cumberland Mountain Community Services Board is August 31, 2013. Any record not requested in that time period will be destroyed.
